# Herbert W Armstrong The Office that He Served In

There was a time in the in the 20<sup>th</sup> century when the Church of God was in harmony. The Church was growing in both income and membership. Congregation sizes numbered in the hundreds. Bible studies, socials and other events were common place and were attended by large groups of brethren. Numerous feast sites were established throughout the world and feast site attendance at each location numbered in the thousands. The Church and its members were thriving, and at its peak, the total attendance throughout the world surpassed 140,000.

The Plain Truth Magazine, the spearhead that was used to take the gospel to the world was growing by leaps and bounds. It reached a monthly circulation of 8 million copies per month at its pinnacle. The world also heard the one true gospel by way of radio and television. The World Tomorrow Program, a nationally and internationally program was telecast every Sunday morning. And it was seen by at least a million viewers every week.

Amazing truths that had been previously lost to the Church had been restored and explained in plain and simple language. The Bibles greatest prophecies were unsealed and revealed, and its events synchronized so that the average person could understand the staggering events that will be upon us in the near future. New members were being added to each congregation on a monthly basis and the brethren were excited.

Three college campuses were established to train leaders and a ministry. One was established in Pasadena California, another in Big Sandy Texas and a third in Brick Wood England. An ordained ministry that reached a size of over 1,200 men served congretions throughout the world, with over 600 of these men on a full time salary.

And even after the Church was derailed and numerous doctrines watered down in the 1970's, it was put doctrinally back on the track. The entire Church spoke and believed the same thing once again in the 1980's and it was united in one mind in the truth. This 20<sup>th</sup> century marked the golden era in the history and growth of God's Church.

But how did this happen? How was the truth restored to the Church? What was the cause for this phenomenal growth? How did the Church achieve such harmony? Why did God bless the Church? And what was the key that made this possible? You are about to learn the vital element that made all of this possible.

# **Selected by God**

The year was 1927 when God began working with a man by the name of Herbert W Armstrong. A staggering prophecy was on the verge of being fulfilled. The birth of the Philadelphia era of the Church (Revelation 3:7-8)

was about to begin and a door would swing wide open for a great work to be accomplished around the globe (Matthew 24:14).

The Sardis era of the Church of God was on the verge of closing having lost most of the truths of God (Revelation 3:1-2) and the time was ripe for a massive restoration of truth to occur and for the gospel to be preached throughout the earth. But first, a man had to be selected by God (John 15:16) to lead God's people before this could occur. And so, here is what Mr. Armstrong came to learn about his selection to lead the Church of God in the 20<sup>th</sup> century and to preach the gospel thoughout the world:

"Well, no man made me an apostle and men cannot elect an apostle. That would never have the approval of God in a million years. Christ Himself selected me, and laid on me the Great Commission of getting the gospel of the Kingdom of God, which is the good news of the coming government and kingdom of God, to all the world."

"Forty-three years ago, God committed to me His GREAT COMMISSION — to carry Christ's Gospel MESSAGE\_of the imminent coming KINGDOM OF GOD into all the world.

"Again I say that is a STAGGERING RESPONSIBILITY!

"Alone, I would be utterly helpless to carry out that commission. Therefore, God used me first in raising up HIS CHURCH of this era, to stand loyally in back of me, making it possible.

"The parent church was 19 members. That was in August 1933. I had really been given the GREAT COMMISSION in mid-July of that year when I was 40. <u>I was not elected; I was appointed by Jesus Christ, the HEAD of the Church.</u> How may that be known? By THE FRUITS — BY THE FACTS, which cannot be contradicted!"

## **Trained by Jesus Christ**

And so, Mr. Armstrong was chosen to lead the Church of God in the Philadelphia era and to preach the gospel to the world. But he was not just selected to do this, he was also trained by Jesus Christ. Just as Christ worked with and taught the original apostles in person when he walked this earth, he trained and taught Mr. Armstrong through the written Word of God.

Apostles are taught and instructed by Christ. This is how the apostle Paul was trained (Galatians 1:16-24 and I Corinthians 9:1). Mr. Armstrong understood this and he knew that he had been instructed by Christ in a similar manner. The following are Mr. Armstrong's words on how he was trained and educated by Jesus Christ:

"And HOW did God put doctrine and belief into His Church? By Jesus Christ—but Christ taught the Apostles and the CHURCH received its teaching and doctrines through the APOSTLES. Now Jesus is the Word of God in Person. The BIBLE is the Word of God in writing—but the SAME TRUTH! Brethren. I did not put myself into God's Church nor make myself Christ's Apostle—HE DID! Just as God taught the first century original Apostles through Jesus the Personal Word of God, even so He taught me the SAME TRUTHS AND DOCTRINES through the WRITTEN Word of God, the Holy Bible!"

#### **TRUTH Enters the Church**

But what was it that Christ taught Mr. Armstrong? What was it that he learned from this great teacher? The information that he gained from Jesus Christ was the knowledge of the TRUTH. And so, in 1927, he began to receive the true doctrines that are revealed in the Bible directly from Christ. Apostles receive the knowledge of the TRUTH straight from Jesus Christ.

The year 1933 marked the dawn of the Philadelphia era of the Church. An era that would see the full truth restored through a man who would lead the Church for nearly 53 years. Proof that the truth was restored to the Philadelphia era is found in Revelation 3:8 and 10 which states that this era kept the Word of Christ. One cannot keep the Word of Christ, which is the Word of truth, unless it was restored to the Church. And here is how Jesus Christ restored the truth to the Worldwide Church of God by using a human apostle as his instrument:

"But God was revealing His truth to me. At first I had to learn a doctrine at a time. In other words, if the whole truth were a jigsaw puzzle of 100 pieces, I found the Church of God of the Sardis era, even though God's Church, had lost about 75 of the pieces, though some were among the important pieces. But it was impossible to fit them together so as to produce the WHOLE and FULL PICTURE, plain and clear.

"God was inspiring me to fill in the gaps...

"<u>Little by little, God revealed to me more and more TRUTHS</u> — additional pieces of God's revealed KNOWLEDGE that filled in the gaps — answered all the questions."

Philadelphia era. I came in the very tail end of the Sardis era of the church. It was the true Church of God, but they had lost so much of the original knowledge and truth ... So many things that God revealed to me that first year, a lot He didn't reveal until later.

"Now really, what I'm saying is that all of the doctrine, all of what we believe, and what the church believed 1900 years ago, was put into the church by the apostles. And it comes, now Christ had taught them directly. But Jesus is the word of God in person, and Christ's apostle today got the same truth from the word of God in print. #### **One Sent Forth**

With God now having selected and trained a man to lead his Church in the Philadelphia era, and with the restoration of truth well on its way, the foundation was set and the time had come for the fulfillment of Matthew 24:14, the preaching of the one true gospel. And the good news of the kingdom of God was preached throughout the world through an open door, just as prophesied in Revelation 3:7-8. The stage was now set and the time had finally arrived for this powerful work to begin.

One of the most important commissions given to an apostle is to preach the gospel of the kingdom of God. They are the ones specifically "sent forth" with this commission. This is what the word apostle means, and it is the gospel they are "sent forth" to preach. It is not often this office is given and men are "sent forth" with this commission. But it occurred in the 20<sup>th</sup> century.

And so, the preaching of the one true gospel began in 1933 in the United States with the start of the first World Tomorrow radio broadcast. And in February of 1934, The *Plain Truth* was published for the first time. It

began with a circulation of 50 magazines by the one selected, trained and "sent forth", Mr. Herbert W Armstrong.:

"And Peter then was led out of the prison because the brethren had prayed. You see, the lay members of the Church were given the part of backing the apostles who were to get the gospel out. The word 'apostle' simply means 'one sent forth' with the gospel. And it was the apostles that were taking the gospel to the world, not the lay members, but the lay members backed them with their prayers, with their tithes and in every way with their encouragement, every way that they could."

# You Shall Know Them by Their Fruits

But how can one know that the office of an apostle was given in the 20<sup>th</sup> century? After all, anyone can claim they are serving in this office. There is one sure way to know. The litmus test for determining if the office of an apostle has been given is found in Matthew 7:16. In these verses, Jesus Christ said "You shall know them by their fruits". Christ himself provided a way to know if someone has been sent as an apostle.

There was a time when the membership of the Worldwide Church of God believed that an apostle, under Jesus Christ, was leading the Church. They fruits of an apostle were obvious to the membership. The brethren and the ministry were able to recognize that Mr. Armstrong was an apostle long before he acknowledged it himself. And once again, it was because everyone could see the fruits. The following is from the archives of the Worldwide Church of God that further explains this point:

"I am not here because a lot of people decided to vote for me, or put me here. You had nothing to do with me becoming God's apostle. Someone says to me, 'Well Mr. Armstrong, how did you know you're God's Apostle?'

"... Well, I will answer just as Jesus Christ answered when the messengers of John the Baptist came to Him and said, 'Well, John wants to know, are You really the Messiah that was to come?' Jesus didn't say yes or no. He said, 'You go tell John what you hear and what you see being done. Go and show him the fruit of what you see coming from Me' and by their fruits you shall know.

"No, back in 1933, I didn't know. Well, how do I know now? <u>Because I looked back on all these years</u> <u>and I see the fruits</u>. And you're here as part of it! You're part of the evidence! Because you're here and I had something to do with that and so did Jesus Christ."

"Now let me just say that <u>God has put one apostle in His Church</u>. I have never claimed to be that apostle. That is, I didn't originally until I found that all of the Church recognized it anyway. <u>And I would just simply point to 50 years of the fruits, and what has happened, and what God has done, and how <u>He has used me in the last 50 years.</u></u>

## The Magnitude of the Great Work

In the 20<sup>th</sup> century, a great servant of God by the name of Herbert W Armstrong appeared on the world scene. #### The Seal of an Apostle

But there is another way that one can verify that the office of an apostle has been given. The seal of a true apostle are the conversions, the baptisms that occur during their ministry. You and I are the living proof that validates the seal of an apostle, "for the seal of mine apostleship are ye in the Lord", I Corinthians 9:2. With a Church attendance topping 150,000 at its peak, there can be no doubt of the seal of Mr. Armstrong's apostleship:

"In I Corinthian s, chapter 9, the apostle Paul shows the proof of his apostleship: 'Are not ye my work in the Lord? If I be not an apostle unto others, yet doubtless I am to you: for the seal of mine apostleship are ye in the Lord' (I Cor. 9:1-2).

"Just as proofs in the life of Paul set him forth has an apostle of Jesus Christ, in our time another has also been used by God in a powerful way. Through him, the Worldwide Church of God was established. Through him, the doctrines of God were restored to the Body of Christ. Through him, directly or indirectly, all of us in the Church have come to the knowledge of the truth, repentance and baptism. Through him, demons have been cast out and many have been healed - even of cancer. Isn't that the fruit, the seal of apostleship?

"<u>Directly, or indirectly, you are all MY children in the Lord.</u> This Church is GOD'S Church. Jesus Christ is its living HEAD. He chose and has used me as His Apostle — as His human servant and instrument through whom HE, not just I, raised up all this Church. It was God the Father who called me, and later all of you. Jesus Christ founded and built God's Church. <u>He raised up and built the present</u>

Philadelphia era of God's Church. But He used me as the human instrument in so doing.

"WHERE DID YOU GET YOUR BELIEF — THE DOCTRINES WE ALL HOLD SO DEARLY? Every doctrine — every point of belief — you received directly or indirectly through me as Christ's Apostle!"

"Our ministers are being swamped with calls for counseling about baptism by prospective new members. This is becoming a problem, because as Jesus said, the harvest is plenteous, but the laborers are few. We now have 583 ordained ministers worldwide serving full time, but they are much overworked."

#### The Authenticity of the Truth

One of the most important doctrines that Jesus Christ revealed to the Church through Mr. Armstrong is that *TRUTH ONLY ENTERS THE CHURCH THROUGH THE OFFICE OF AN APOSTLE*. This is the way that a member in the Church can validate the authenticity of a doctrinal truth. Christ put this method by which truth enters the Church to prevent the infiltration of false doctrines.

All truth emanates from the Father. The Father in turn gives these truths to Jesus Christ. All truth is put into the Church of God by Jesus Christ, the living Head of the Church, through the office of an apostle. No other office in the Church has the authority to alter, remove or water down the doctrines that were placed in the Church by Jesus Christ, though an apostle.

Therefore, no leader of a Church of God group has the authority to changed, removed, or watered down the doctrines that were placed in the Church by Jesus Christ through His chosen apostle Mr. Armstrong. The groups that engage in this are not being led by Jesus Christ. In addition, you will soon come to see that even an apostle can never establish a doctrine that contradicts the doctrines that were established by another apostle. This would lead to confusion.

The following quotes are from a pool of many statements that Mr. Armstrong made regarding this key teaching. And they perfectly line up with what the scriptures reveal on this important point:

"In our day, Jesus Christ taught His chosen apostle through the written Word of God. The Worldwide Church of God — the same Church as founded in A.D. 31 — received its DOCTRINE through God's chosen Apostles!"

**Comment:** There are two important points regarding this subject. Point number one is, no one except an apostle is authorized to introduce a new truth, remove a truth, or alter a truth that has been established by an apostle. Point number two is, a true apostle will never contradict the truths established by another apostle. This is because there is only one body of beliefs and also because the truth doesn't change.

"God says: 'There is one body, and one Spirit, even as ye are called in one hope of your calling; one Lord, one faith . . .' (Eph. 4:4-5).

"One faith - meaning one body of beliefs, one set of doctrines, one perfectly harmonious truth believed and practiced by the true Church of God. Unless a point of truth you may believe fits perfectly and harmoniously into the whole of the doctrine of Christ - unless each truth you have learned only further serves to elucidate, clarify and further explain the whole of the plan of God - then it may not be a 'truth,' but error."

"This faith, meaning in this sense the body of beliefs and practices handed down by the apostles, forms the essence of the meaning of God's Church ...

#### The Apostles Doctrine

Mr. Armstrong was adamant regarding the subject of how truth enters the Church. He stated this as often as he talked about the one true gospel. This teaching is also perfectly in line with the way the government of God functions, which is a hierarchical government that works from the top down. All truth comes from God the Father to Jesus Christ and then flows to the Church through the office of an apostle.

Some might ask, "Is there any scriptural proof to validate what Mr. Armstrong taught on this topic?" There certainly is. Acts 15 is a good example of how a new teaching enters the Church. The following are a few additional verses on this subject:

"And <u>they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine</u> and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers." Acts 2:42

"And I say also unto thee, That thou art Peter, and upon this rock I will build my church; and the gates of hell shall not prevail against it. And I will give unto thee the keys of the kingdom of heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt bind on earth shall be bound in heaven: and whatsoever thou shalt loose on earth shall be loosed in heaven." Matthew 16:18-19

"And are built upon the foundation of the apostles and prophets, Jesus Christ himself being the chief corner stone; In whom all the building fitly framed together groweth unto an holy temple in the Lord:" Ephesians 2:20-21

#### **Will Not Compromise**

As was previously mentioned in this article, Mr. Armstrong was an individual who was personally selected by God to serve as an apostle. But have you ever wondered why he was specifically chosen for this office? Did he possess a special quality that the great God would choose him to serve in office of an apostle?

We have already read that he was not educated in the universities of this world. This is the first prequalifier. But there is a specific reason he was chosen for this office. In the 1970's, first in 1974 and then again in 1978, Mr. Armstrong had to remove men from the ministry. These were individuals who began to change and water down the doctrines that Jesus Christ had revealed to the Church through God's 20<sup>th</sup> century apostle.

When these conspiracies came to light, this old but wise apostle did not waver, falter and did not compromise. He thundered into action and set the Church back on track doctrinally and he did this when he was in his 80's.

God selected Mr. Armstrong as the apostle who would lead the Philadelphia era of the Church for one main reason. God hand picked him for this office because he knew that Herbert W Armstrong would not compromise on the truth, no matter the consequences. This is the special quality that he possessed and the reason he was chosen by God for this office. Holding fast to the truth and not compromising is a hallmark of all true Philadelphian brethren (Revelation 3:8 &10). And oh, what a rare commodity this is in these final years of this age:

"But there has been an effort to water down the truth. That's another thing that has happened in the last 9 years. We're trying to water down the truth of God with false doctrines that have been creeping in and ministers are teaching them, around the world even ministers of this Church! Now, believe you me, I am going to get after those things, and fast!

"Jesus Christ is in power. Jesus Christ is the power back of it and He is going to set these things in order. And if any of you want to fight Christ, you start fighting Him and see where you get off. Or if you want to go with the devil, maybe you'll suffer the devil's fate. I am speaking very plainly today. I'm a little wrought up about it.

"Revelation 3:8 I know... He knows our works. So there are works and they're good works, and not rituals. Behold, He set this open door. You have but a little strength, and hast kept my word.

# "I was going to say, if there is any one reason why God called me, it is because I was willing to believe what He said, and because I had kept His Word and I have not compromised."

"God revealed truth to me and if there is any reason why He has chose me, there's only one. It's not because of any righteousness of mine, it's not because of any abilities or powers of mine. I've known scores upon scores of men with better minds than I have, better personality, better appearance, more leadership, I'd say about more of everything that you think of humanly. But God has not called them or used them. Why? Why did He pick on one as inferior as I am? Because I was willing to believe Him. Adam and Eve didn't believe Him. Jesus Christ talked to thousands who didn't believe Him. Only a hundred and twenty still believed Him after Christ had talked for three and a half years to multiple thousands of people.

"But I did believe Him, and I have not compromised with that belief one iota and I've been working hard the last two and a half years to get this Church back on the track after others were getting it off the track. I don't think we are a hundred percent back yet. I don't think we have gotten all of the leaven out yet. But it's going out, believe me, and we're going to get it out."

"For some few years now, there had been a certain group at Headquarters, whom my son surrounded himself with, who have wanted to 'water down' God's truths and doctrines. They seem to have wanted to get as close to the ways of Satan as possible, still keeping 'one foot' in God's Church, hoping thereby to get into the Kingdom of God.

"I want to get as CLOSE to GOD's true doctrines as possible, and as far away from Satan's ways as possible.

"If there is any reason why the living Christ chose me as His Apostle, it is that I will not compromise a thousandth of an inch on God's true doctrines."

"The group of 'liberals' which my son surrounded himself with, who wanted to alter and modify or change GOD'S LAW AND DOCTRINES, are being put out. FOR THE FIRST TIME IN TEN YEARS, GOD'S CHURCH AND ITS LEADERS AT HEADQUARTERS ARE IN HARMONY, IN GOD'S TRUTH, IN PEACE, AND IN HIS LOVE!"

**Comment:** There are 3 characteristics that all true apostles have in common. The first one is, that an apostle will always stand up for, uphold, and teach the truth. The second one is, that an apostle will always preach the one true gospel. This commission is directly related to the meaning of the office of an apostle which is one who is "sent forth". And the third factor is that an apostle always bears fruit, and the fruit will lead to conversions. This is how one can tell that the office has been given by God.

## **Agreed With Christ**

The Worldwide Church of God received it's teachings from the man who served in the office of an apostle for 53 years, Mr. Armstrong. Mr. Armstrong in turn received the truth directly from Jesus Christ. And Jesus Christ received the truth from God the Father.

This is the same truth that the Church of God received in the first century by the apostles who learned it directly from Jesus Christ. And it is the same truth that the Worldwide Church of God received from the apostle who lived in the 20<sup>th</sup> century, Mr. Armstrong.

The apostles and the Church of God must always be agreed with Christ in truth. He is the living HEAD of the Church and one who places the doctrines in the body of Christ. The entire Church, from 31 A.D when the Church began until the return of Christ, must agree with Christ in doctrine, once again because it is He who is the one that places the truth in the Church.

This was a point that Mr. Armstrong stressed when he put the *Worldwide Church of God* back on the track, after liberal men had infiltrated the Church altered the truth in the 1970's. And thus, in the 1980's the Church was back on track and in harmony with Jesus Christ. Therefore, the Church of God must always be agreed with Christ in doctrinal truth:

"When he [Paul] came back from Arabia, he went over to Jerusalem to compare with the apostles who had been taught by Christ when He was here in physical person before His crucifixion to see if they were speaking the same thing — because Paul had been instructed by Christ that we must ALL speak the same thing. And that 'same thing' must come from God, through Christ, through an apostle, to us. That's the way they got it. That's the way we have to get it today. And when Paul came to Jerusalem, he talked to Peter and others there and found he had been told the same thing by the same Christ that they had been told, and they had absolute harmony and agreement. He wanted to be sure that they all had the same truth — direct from Christ."

"Two can't walk together except they be AGREED! I now AGREED with Christ. I have NEVER DISAGREED. You yourself—every begotten child of God—does, through human weakness, commit sin even after the most deep conversion. None has lived perfectly but JESUS. But when I stumbled through human weakness, Jesus picked me back up on confessing to Him and repenting, and asking help never to repeat the sin. At no point did I DISAGREE nor water down HIS TRUTH. He used me in building the Philadelphia era of HIS CHURCH—and in proclaiming His Gospel IN ALL THE WORLD!"

"I BELIEVED Christ, the living Word of God. Through human weakness I have not lived perfectly — I have stumbled and fallen down a few times as <u>I have WALKED WITH CHRIST WITH WHOM I AM IN</u> **AGREEMENT!** But I have repented of that, worked on myself to OVERCOME — cried out to God for

divine HELP in overcoming this weak human flesh. **But I have WALKED WITH CHRIST BECAUSE I AM IN AGREEMENT WITH HIM!** 

"But it is still true that two can't walk together except they be agreed. I am agreed with God and with Christ the Head of the Church. I shall never water down the TRUTH He has revealed to me, nor in any manner compromise with it. We are ALL OF US going to have to AGREE with God and with Christ HIS Son, if we are to walk together with them, into God's Kingdom."

#### He that Receives Me

We have just seen that Mr. Armstrong had a conviction to serve God without compromise. This is reflective by the actions he took and by the many statements he made throughout his life, but especially when he set the Church back on track in the 1970's. He was firm, resolute and determined during the course of his ministry not to make any concessions with the truths that God had revealed to him during the course of his life. To this end, he was faithful until his death.

There are some who no longer believe what Mr. Armstrong taught. They reject him as an apostle and some even believe that he was a false prophet. There are others who water down and reject numerous doctrines that were established as truths in the Worldwide Church of God by God's 20<sup>th</sup> century apostle.

And then there are some, who claim to be holding fast to the truths that he restored. They make statements such as "the new teachings that are being revealed are lining up with what Mr. Armstrong taught". Yet they reject him as the end-time Elijah and alter many of the prophetic truths that were revealed to the Church through him, including the truth of the one truth gospel of the kingdom of God.

Those that do this fail to remember the words of Jesus Christ in John 13:20. They also forget the important lesson of I Samuel 8:4-7. These are verses that we must never forget because they go to the heart of how God feels about not accepting an apostle or leader that God has sent. Everyone in the Worldwide Church of God once understood that implications of rejecting the one that God has sent:

"Note that Malachi 3:1 says, 'Behold, I will send.' <u>An apostle is one sent.</u> <u>Mr. Armstrong is fulfilling</u> <u>this passage</u>, and thus even this Old Testament verse shows that he is an apostle — 'one sent forth.' God says that before Christ's return, He would send someone...

"Here are the words of Jesus Christ, 'Verily, verily, I say unto you, <u>He that receiveth whomsoever I send receiveth me</u>; and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me' (John 13:20).

"Notice that <u>Jesus is referring to the one that He sends.</u> <u>If we receive the one that He sends, His</u> apostle, then we are receiving Jesus Christ and the Father. On the other hand, if we reject the one

## whom Christ has sent, we reject Christ.

"This lesson is made clear in the Old Testament account of Samuel. After the people had rejected Samuel, God told him, 'they have not rejected thee, but they have rejected me, that I should not reign over them' (I Sam. 8:7)."

#### Conclusion

The 20<sup>th</sup> was the golden era of the Church of God. This era began with 19 members in 1933 and closed with a Church attendance of over 140,000 at its peak. A massive restoration of truth accompanied by the preaching of the gospel marked the beginning of a prophecy in Revelation 3:7 and the fulfillment of Matthew 24:14.

And the key involved an office that was given to a man in the last century, the office of an apostle. Herbert W Armstrong was the individual who was used by God as the instrument to accomplish His mighty end-time work. He was the one who was sent and announced the good news of the soon coming kingdom of God throughout the globe. And this great servant of God was selected by Him because he would not compromise the truth, the truth that was restored to the Worldwide Church of God by Jesus Christ:

"No MAN, of himself, could have decided to do this, and, on his own human ability and power alone, have RAISED up this Worldwide Church of God, have developed the facilities and machinery for BROADCASTING THAT ANNOUNCEMENT — by radio, printing press, television, personal preaching to THE WORLD. This WORK OF GOD has grown into a great, powerful WORLDWIDE and WORLD-KNOWN work.

"There is but one answer. No one can believe that I alone had the ability and the power to accomplish something that never before in the history of man has been done! GOD DID IT, though He used me as a human servant. No MAN BY HUMAN ABILITY COULD HAVE ACHIEVED IT.

"Yet God always has worked through ONE MAN, surrounded by helpers."
